#### Arrival + Parking

Drop off only allowed in Beadnell, no parking available due to the car park being used for our event.

#### Club buses

No club buses allowed in Beadnell, drop off just off the main road and walk down.

Parking in Alnmouth is limited. If there are no spaces, instruct your driver to park at Willowburn Leisure Centre in Alnwick and return for pick up after the event.

Buses will leave Hisburn First School (Sat Nav NE66 3PX) from 7.00am and the last bus will leave at 8.00am. Please be prompt, we do not have time to wait after that.

#### Race Route

There is new route this year due to the National Trust not allowing access to part of the beach. There are maps of the route online at <a href="www.alnwickharriers.co.uk">www.alnwickharriers.co.uk</a>. Cut off time is 3 hours 15 minutes. Any runner after that will not have their time recorded.

Marshalls will be along the route to direct you, please follow their guidance especially along the bird sanctuary at Long Nanny where you must go over the bridge and not through the water.
